| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Hwy 404 North to the Green Lane exit</li> <li>2. Follow the signs East to Hwy 48 - go North</li> <li>3. North on Hwy 12</li> <li>4. North/East to go back onto County Road 48</li> <li>5. Turn left and go North on Hwy 35 at Coboconk</li> <li>6. <b>Do not take County 121 south to Kinmount (just before Minden)</b></li> </ol> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7. Stay on 35 for 1.5 km <b>past Minden</b> to County Rd. 21 (formerly 121)</li> <li>8. North on 21 to HALIBURTON Village</li> <li>9. Turn left at 2<sup>nd</sup> stoplight onto Hwy 118 West</li> <li>10. Turn right on County Rd. 14 (Haliburton Lake Road)</li> <li>11. Camp is on right (<b>8 km past Eagle Lake</b>)</li> <li>12. Camp address: 4250 Haliburton Lake Road</li> </ol> |

### HWY. 400 ROUTE

1. Hwy 400 North to Hwy 11
2. Hwy 11 North to Hwy 118 (at Bracebridge)
3. Hwy 118 East to the town of CARNARVON
4. Cross over Hwy 35, continue on Hwy 118 towards Haliburton
5. At County Road 14 (Haliburton Lake Road) turn left and go north to Eagle Lake
6. Remain on Haliburton Lake Road 8 km past Eagle Lake
7. Camp is on your right: 4250 Haliburton Lake Road
